# Letter of Intent

Below are the details regarding the Letter of Intent to run for office:

A letter of intent is a written document or email that expresses what position your school is running for and why you are interested in running for that position. It should be double spaced and no more than one page and length. Most importantly, it must include two signatures: one from an advisor and one from the principal. This year, letters will be submitted via google form and are due by January 31st, 2025.

# Overall Campaigning Instructions

Below are details regarding the processes for campaigning and skits for Convention 2025:

Those campaigning at Convention must send at least one student representative and one adult to the virtual election meeting to receive both final reminders and certification that you are eligible to run.

# Speeches

A copy of the script for each speech must be sent to [parli@georgiastuco.com](mailto:parli@georgiastuco.com) by Friday, February 14, 2025 at 4pm. Candidates will be required to present two speeches at general sessions. The first speech (given at General Session 1) should be an introductory speech given by one person that lasts no longer than one minute. The second speech (given at the General Election Meeting) should be more detailed but no longer than two minutes. The second speech may be given by one or two people.

# Skits

There will be one skit presented at Convention. Each candidate school is allowed four minutes to perform a live campaign skit. Sound will be cut at exactly four minutes. The skit should focus on the school's qualifications for office and **MUST** be **EXACTLY** on what was presented during the skit rehearsal meeting at 3pm on Thursday, February 20th . Any technology needs should be sent via email to the parliamentarian school a least two weeks prior to convention.

# Campaign Materials

What can we use in our campaign?

- Social Media posts/videos (10 pieces of content)
- Yard Signs
- Buttons or Wristbands

What are we NOT allowed to use?

- No candy
- No hanging posters (posters can only be held or put in the ground--see yard signs above)
- No other tangible giveaways

As a friendly reminder, campaigning may not start until the conclusion of the first campaign meeting. If a campaign school would like to use any other platforms/resources to campaign, a request for approval must be emailed to [parli@georgiastuco.com](mailto:parli@georgiastuco.com).

## Advisor Responsibilities

Advisors should sign the Letter of Intent and ensure that the principal has also signed the letter of intent.

At least one advisor must be present at the virtual meeting and Convention. If elected, at least one advisor must be prepared to attend all GASC Executive Board meetings and GASC events.
